



Becoming a Registered Canadian Reflexology Therapist (RCRT™) *with the Reflexology Association of Canada (R.A.C)*

Must be fully trained and **certified** as a reflexologist.

Certification training must include:

- Completed Core reflexology course
- Completed hands-on training in reflexology techniques
- Passed a written exam (80%)
- Completed practicum that includes Case Studies which have been reviewed by a licensed instructor.
- Passed in-person practical exam (80%)

Apply to take the RCRT™ Exam with R.A.C.

Complete the R.A.C. RCRT™ Written & Practical Exams

Pass = 80% in both exams

Become a R.A.C. Professional Member in good standing

Eligible to use the RCRT™ designation
